Additionally, those packs designated as medical devices, are CE marked under the EU regulation 2017/745 and CA marked under the UK regulation 2002.

In addition to the standard MicronDevices range, Micronclean create bespoke packs to suit the individual needs of customers and their compounding sessions. Working closely with the customer, Micronclean will take a requirement from concept through to delivery, managing the entire process using in-house expertise in such areas as packaging, labelling, sterilisation and regulatory compliance.
