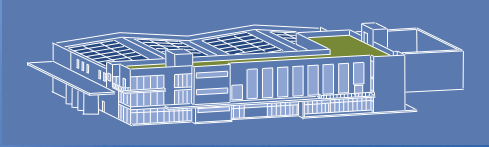

Routine 100% incoming product inspection helps reduce rejection rates, and our in-house team can rapidly develop custom packs to meet customer-specific requirements.
